## Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committees.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials, or be on the show grounds, the ALAC will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive a veterinarian certificate of such a claim before the start of judging for the trial to be eligible for refund.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committees, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. ALAC has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

Entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must complete back of form. Include only AKC titles on entries. CGC is not an AKC title.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or in the event of cancellation of entries after the published closing date. **Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date.** No refunds for duplicate entries.

Dogs under 6 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

## Hotel Information

**Block room rate** is \$99 plus tax. Four dog limit to each room.

Dogs must be crated (not in exercise pens) in guestrooms at all times. Plastic is required under crates in the room. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Dogs may be bathed in guestrooms but all blow drying and grooming must be done in the ballroom grooming area. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

There is a designated lot for 10-12 RV's at the Hotel Carlisle. No Hook-ups. Fee is \$35.00 or free to registered guests. All RV's must be in the designated area, self contained, and the space must be left in a clean condition. ### **PLEASE NOTE:**

All exhibitors must be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on the hotel and trial grounds. Any damages to the hotel or the trial site can result in disciplinary action by the Trial Committee. It is expected that exhibitors will clean up immediately after their own dogs and strongly encourage others to do the same.

All owners/exhibitors should be aware that the entire hotel grounds are considered within the trial grounds. You will be responsible for all damage to your room and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. Any abuse of the grounds will be brought to the attention of the trial-giving club and its Trial Committee. Any exhibitor's entries may be refused for previous misuse of the hotel facilities. This is an AKC supported measure.

### Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to Lhasa Apsos over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have Limited Registration or ILP/PAL numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

### Obstacles

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

### Course Familiarization

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog prior to the start of the class to plan their running strategy. A warm-up area consisting of a regulation jump shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may not use the warm up area to relieve their dogs.

### Prizes and Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to First Place through Fourth Place in each jump height in each class. Qualifying rosettes will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons.

If your confirmation information states "Needs To Be Measured," your dog **must** be measured before he/she can run. That measurement will only be for this trial. Measuring will begin at 8:00 AM.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, and Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
