

ALAC Lifetime Achievement Award

An award presented annually or when there are eligible recipients approved by the ALAC board, or an appropriate committee, so designated by the board.

The criteria for this award are as follows:

- Must be a member in good standing for a minimum of twenty-five consecutive years and be nominated by a member of ALAC on the required form.
- In addition, the member must have served on a committee or been an officer or board member for a total of at least ten years. The person does not have to have served consecutive years and may have served on different committees or, on the board that, in total of all service, equals at least ten years. Breeder judges who are also mentors could be included, as well as show chair, show committee, JEC, ways and means, rescue work, etc.
- We will honor these persons each year in the Bulletin and they will be recognized at the annual meeting or banquet. For the first several years, there may be several persons who have already met the requirements.

Each year all current and previous recipients will be listed in the national specialty catalogue. An award or gift is not required.
